Hmwrk – Tsi-/G- Pronouns

Given the 3<sup>rd</sup> Person Singular form of a Cherokee Verb Word and one other Person form, you can predict/deduce the other Person forms. There are four primary Person marking patterns for the Tsi-/G- Set Pronouns.

Tsi- ~ Ga- Consonant Stem Pattern:

Third Person Singular is ga- and other forms occur in their i-Consonant Stem patterns.

## G- ~ G- Vowel Stem Pattern:

Third Person Singular is g- and other forms occur in their non-i-Vowel Stem patterns.

### Tsi- ~ A- Consonant Stem Pattern:

Third Person Singular is a- and other forms occur in their i-Consonant Stem patterns.

## G- ~ A- Vowel Stem Pattern:

Third Person Singular is a- and other forms occur in their non-i-Vowel Stem patterns.

# Based on prompts, isolate the Present Verb Stem and write out and translate the other Present Verb Stem forms.

Prompt: Galogwe gvsgaladi'a. He is hiding a gun. Galogwe gvsgaladi'a. I am hiding a gun.

Analysis – Third Person Singular Pronoun is g- and First Person Singular is g-. This Present Stem Verb follows the G- ~ G- Vowel Stem Pattern.

Answer: The Present Verb Stem is –vsgaladi'a 'is hiding it [long/rigid]'.

Hvsgaladi'a. You are hiding it [long/rigid].

Osdvsgaladi'a. He and I are hiding it [long/rigid].

Otsvsgaladi'a. They and I are hiding it [long/rigid].

Invsgaladi'a. You and I are hiding it [long/rigid].

Idvsgaladi'a. You all and I are hiding it [long/rigid].

Sdvsgaladi'a. You two are hiding it [long/rigid].

Itsvsgaladi'a. You all are hiding it [long/rigid].

Anvsgaladi'a. They are hiding it [long/rigid].
