-ahnawo 'shirt' a-Vowel Stem, agw- ~ u- Pronoun Pattern, Singular Paradigm:

my shirt Agwahnawo		your shirt Tsahnawo	his/her shirt Uhnawo
*my and her shirt Oginahnawo	my and your shirt Ginahnawo	you two's shirt Sdahnawo	
my and their shirt Ogahnawo	my and you all's Igahnawo	you all's shirt Itsahnawo	their shirt Unahnawo

*just one shirt, possessed by me and her

-asulo 'pants' a-Vowel Stem, agw- ~ u- Pronoun Pattern, Plural Paradigm:

my pants Digwasulo		your pants Ditsasulo	her/his pants Tsusulo
my and his pants Tsoginasulo	my and your pants Diginasulo	you two's pants Disdasulo	
my and thier pants Tsogasulo	my and you all's Digasulo	you all's pants *Ditsasulo	their pants Tsunasulo

*Accented i vowel distinguishes Singular and Plural in this case.

-oyeni 'hand' Vowel Stem, agw- ~ uw- Pronoun Pattern, Plural Paradigm

my hands Digwoyeni		your hands Ditsoyeni	his/her hands Tsuwoyeni
my and her hands Tsoginoyeni	my and your hands Diginoyeni	you two's hands Disdoyeni	
my and their hands Tsogoyeni	my and you all's Digoyeni	you all's hands Ditsoyeni	their hands Tsunoyeni

-nogeni 'arm' ga-Consonant Stem, tsi- ~ ga- Pronoun Pattern, Plural Paradigm

my arms Ditsinogeni		your arms Tihnogeni	her/his arms Dikanogen
my and his arms Tsoginihnogeni	my and your arms Diginihnogeni	you two's arms Disdihnnogeni	
my and their arms Tsogihnnogeni	my and you all's Digihnnogeni	you all's arms *Ditsi:hnogeni	their arms Tsunihnnogeni

*Accented i vowel and long i: distinguish First Singular and Second Plural
