gowelisgv'i, vmpf, dk, I was writing., [ohwe:l], g~g, write
hohwelvga, vimd, dk, Write it!, [ohwe:l], g~g, write
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Dictionary Entry

gowelisgv'i, vmpf, dk, I was writing., [ohwe:l], g~g, write

First Person Singular Tsi-/G-Pronoun conditions glottal alternation.

Go'welisgvi. I was writing. Glottal /h/ becomes /'/.

Gohweli'a. She is writing.

Gowelisgv'i. I was writing.

Hohwelvga! Write it!

Tsi-/G- Set Pronouns

Gohwelia. She is writing.

Gowelia. I am writing.

Deduction: This is a Vowel Stem.

Present Stem: -ohwelia 'writing'

Tsi-/G- Pattern: g- ~ g-

Agi-/Agw- Set Digression

Gohwelia. She is writing.

Gowelia. I am writing.

Deduction: This is a Vowel Stem.

Agi-/Agw- Pattern: agw- ~ uw- (Uwohwelanvi., vprf, He wrote it.)

Tsi-/G- Set G- ~ G- Pattern

Singular Person

Gowelisgvi. I was writing.

Hohwelisgvi. You were writing.

Gohwelisgvi. She was writing.

Tsi-/G- Set G- ~ G- Pattern

Dual Person

Osd-ohwelisgvi.

In-ohwelisgvi.

Sd-ohwelisgvi.

Corpus Check

Find 'write' in the New Testament.

From Dictionary Entry,

Base is [ohwe:1].

Base is the 'write' meaning form that is shared by all Stems.

Search for 'owel' in corpus.

No Present Stems.

Perfective Stem 16+ uwowelanvhi

osdv kanohedv, luga **uwowelanvhi** uw-ohwelan-vhi Perfective Participle 'that which he/she wrote'

Perfective Stem Perfective Participle Future

6 gowelanvhi

3 digowelanvhi

NB: Pronoun Set shift from uw- to g-

j21:25 ... gadanvtesgv elohi nasgwo yakaligigwo goweli nasgi digowelanvhi ...

... I suppose that even the world itself would not contain the books **that should be** written ...

Perfective Stem

j19:22 ... tsinagwvnelv tsagwowelanv, hnagwo ase agwowelanv.

... What I have written, I have written.

ts- Relative Clause marker agw-ohwelan-v Experinced or Participle pronunciation difference

Infinitive Stem
1 agwowelodi 'for me to write'

3j1:13 utsadi iyudalegi **agwowelodi** agihvgi, aseno vtla **digowelodi** yidodagvtani na **yvdagvyowelaneli**; I had many things to write [to thee], but I wish not to write to thee with ink and pen;

NT Corpus – Read Line

2th3:17 ayv gwola agwadayolisdi gesv

2th03:17 The salutation of Paul

agwadayolisdi my greeting agw-ad-ayolisdi from uyolisdi 'for him to greet her'

2th3:17 ... agwvsv agwoyeni agwvtanvhi **agwowelanvhi** ...[written] with my own hand

agwowelanvhi
-owelan- 'wrote Perfective'

2th3:17 ... nasgi digolisdodi tsigi nigadv **goweli**...

... which is a token in every letter...

nigadv goweli every letter

2th3:17 ... nasgiya nigvneho gowelisgoi.

2th03:17 ... so I write.

gowelisgoi I write

Transitive Pronouns partially new.

Transitive Pronouns partially overlap with Tsi-/G- Set Pronouns.

Transitive Pronouns partially overlap with Agi-/Agw- Set Pronouns.

Transitive Pronouns - New

First Singular Acts On Second Sg. 3j1:13 ... aseno vtla digowelodi yidodagvtani na **yvdagvyowelaneli**; ... but I wish not to write to thee with ink and pen;

yvdagvyowelaneli

I am not going to write to you.

yvdagvyowelaneli

- y- Counterfactual
- da-Future
- gvy- 1st Sg. Acts On 2nd Sg.
- -ohwelan- Perfective Stem
- -el- Perfective Stem Dative
- -i Future

Dative 'write to' from 'write'

Dative 'write to; write for'

-ohwelan- 'wrote Perfective' becomes Dative

-ohwelane- 'write to Base'

'write to' Transitive Stems

-ohwelane- 'write to Base'

-ohwelaneh- Imperfective/Present

-ohwelasi Immediate?

-ohwelanel- Perfective

-ohwelanedi Infinitive

Transitive Pronouns partially overlap with Tsi-/G- Set Pronouns.

'write to'

Necessarily Transitive Animate – Animate Writer and Animate Receiver

tsi:y- First Person Singular Pronoun -ohwelaneh- Imperfective/Present

Tsi:yowelaneha. I am writing to her.

Prepare to work through dialogues:

Do hadvneha? What are you doing?

Didehyohvsgi tsi:yowelaneha. I am writing to the teacher.

Vsgi Nigaa!

Vsgi nigaa! That's all.
