## Dictionary Entry

degvtsahlasga, vprs, He is frying meat., g~g, fry

degvtsahlasgv'i, vmpf, He was frying meat., g~g, fry

tvtsahlaga, vimd, Fry meat!, g~g, fry

degvtsahlasgv'i, vmpf, He was frying meat., g~g, fry

degvtsahlasgv'i, vmpf, He was frying meat., g~g, fry

Translate:

Were you frying meat?

Yes, I was frying meat.

degvtsahlasgv'i, vmpf, He was frying meat., g~g, fry

2. Identify the Final and the Verb Stem for the Imperfective Stem forms.

**NB:** De- Event Plural Complication

degvtsahlasgv'i, vmpf, He was frying meat., g~g, fry

#### Translate:

They were frying meat. -v'i Final

Were they frying meat? -e'i Final

They always fry meat. -o'i Final

### Take down forms

Tsitaga degvtsahlasga.

She is frying chicken.

Tsitaga degvtsahlasgv'i.

He was frying chicken.

Tsitaga tvtsahlaga!

Fry chicken!

### Present

Do advneha tsadoda? What is your father doing?

Translate Present:
My father is frying chicken.

### Immediate/Present

Translate:

You, now, Fryer! Fry chicken!

Translate:

Okay, I'm frying chicken.

## Imperfective Habitual

Translate:

Do you always fry chicken?

Translate:

Yes, I always fry chicken.

Imperfective Habitual: Nigohilvisg tsitaga dehvtsahlasgoi?

Vv, nigohilv tsitaga degvtsahlasgoi.

de- -vtsahlasg- Imperfective Stem g- First Person Singular -o'i Habitual
