




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



# Adjectives

Punky Dunk, galtsöhida,

# Physical Quality/Size

Galtsohida.      She/He is fat.

Ulesoda.      He/She is thin.

Adjectives take Person Pronouns.

ga- 'he/she/it' Consonant Stem

u- 'she/he/it' a-Vowel Stem

Tsiltsohida. I am fat.

Agwalesoda. I am thin.

# Person Pronouns

Galtsohida. He is fat.

Tsiltsohida. I am fat.

Tsi- ~ Ga- Consonant Stem Pattern

hi-Itsohida you fat

tsosdi-Itsohida, dini-Itsohida, disdi-Itsohida

tsotsi-Itsohida, didi-Itsohida, ditsi-Itsohida,

dini-Itsohida

# Person Pronouns

## Adjective Plural

ts- before o, u (back vowels)

d- before i (front vowel)

di- with a

tsosdi-Itsohida, dini-Itsohida, disdi-Itsohida

tsotsi-Itsohida, didi-Itsohida, ditsi-Itsohida,

dini-Itsohida

# Person Pronouns

Ulesoda.      She is thin.

Agwalesoda. I am thin.

agw- ~ u- a-Vowel Stem Pattern

tsalesoda you thin

tsoginalesoda, diginalesoda, disdalesoda

tsogalesoda, digalesoda, ditsalsoda

tsunalesoda

# Adjectives and Tense

Gvnige nole unega wesa gesvi.

He was a black and white cat.

gesvi      'it was' carries Tense for Adjective

# Adjectives and Tense

Adjectives are different from Verbs.  
Adjectives do not carry Tense.

Tsiltsohida gesvi. I was fat.

Agwalesoda gesvi. I was thin.

# Adjectives and Negative

Adjectives are different from Verbs.

Adjectives are not marked for Negative.

Gesdi galtsohida yigi Kwvki.

Punky was not fat.

Gesdi ulesoda yigi Kwvki.

Punky was not thin.

# Physical Quality

Gatsanula. She is fast.

Usganoli. She is slow.

Uhlinigida. She is strong/powerful.

Agwahlinigida. I am strong/powerful.

Ulisdi. She is weak.

Agwalisdi. I am weak.

# Body Parts

Gvnige kayvsoli,  
dekanasadvi wasdvi,  
nole ganidadvi wasdvi,  
nole digalena.

He had black on his nose and the tips of his toes, on the end of his tail and his ears.

# Body Parts

kayvsoli	nose
dekanasadvi	toes
ganidadvi	tail
digalena	ears

Body Parts take Person and Number. Note 'toes' Plural Number follows Verb Pattern and 'ears' Plural Number follow Noun Pattern.

# Kayvsoli

-hyvsoli 'nose Base'

ga- 'she/he/it' ga-hyvsoli > kayvsoli

tsiyvsoli 'my nose' h > ' alternation

hihyvsoli 'your nose'

# Noses

Most body parts take Noun/Adjective structure Plural.

tsosdihyvsoli, dinihyvsoli, disdihyvsoli

tsotsihyvsoli, didihyvsoli, ditsihyvsoli

dinihyvsoli

# Dekanasadvi

-hnasadvi 'toe Base'

-vi Final indicates Verb-like structure

ga- 'she/he/it'

ga-hnasadvi > kanasadvi 'his toe'

de- Plural > dekanasadvi 'his toes'

# Toes

de- Plural Verb Plural for -vi Final

detsinasadvi, dehihnasadvi, dekanasadvi  
dosdihnasadvi, dénihnasadvi, desdihnasadvi  
dotsihnasadvi, dédihnasadvi, détsihnasadvi  
dinihnasadvi
