Compile a set of 12 pictures, words, and sentences. Include a Title for the set and a Back Cover for the set. The Title, 12 pages of content, and the Back Cover set will provide a draft for potential future work.

1. Title - Use your imagination. Consider the themes that develop as you work. Try to provide a Cherokee title, but English language title is fine. Examples:

- 3. 12 pictures, words, and sentences. Focus on Nouns, because they are easy to illustrate. Review the Cherokee nouns with which you are familiar. Pick your favorite 12 Nouns.
