I am reading. You are reading. She/He is reading.

Tsi-~ Ga- Pattern: consonant stem with tsi- 'I' and ga- 'she/he/it' (First Person tsi-, Third Person ga-)

Tsiwoniha. Hiwoniha. Gawoniha.

I am speaking. You are speaking. She/He is speaking.

Detsinogi'a. Dehihnogi'a. Dekanogi'a.

I am singing. You are singing. She/He is singing.

G-~A- Pattern: a-stem with g-'I' and a-'she/he/it' (First Person g-, Third Person a-)
