dance Verb Words in Tsisdu nole Wahya, narrative and condensed versions:

DƆʔDYD	They are dancing.	Present
DƆʔDYʔPT	They were dancing.	Imperfective Unexperienced
DƆʔDYʔET	She was dancing.; when she was dancing...	Imperfective
TGƆʔDYʔFʔA	You all will be dancing.	Imperfective Future
SƆʔDYʔEZ	And as I am dancing...	Imperfective Participle
DƆʔDYRT.	I danced.	Perfective Experienced
OƆʔDYRT.	She/He danced.	Perfective Experienced
OƆʔDYʔT.	They danced.	Perfective Experienced
LSƆʔDYB	I'm going to dance.	Perfective Future
LFʔDYB.	She/He is going to dance.	Perfective Future
SƆʔDYBVFT	I dance around.	Perf. Ambulative Imperfective
OƆʔDYʔA	He must dance.; for him to dance	Infinitive
TGƆʔDYʔA	You all must dance.; for you all to dance	Infinitive
