Tsi ~ A Consonant-1 Stem Pattern (with d-Plural for multiple things eaten for this verb)

Tsigi'a. **hyD**. Agi'a. **DyD**I am eating it [solid]. She/he is eating it [solid].

Tsi ~ Ga Consonant-2 Stem Pattern

Tsisadosga. **ktV0S**. Gasadosga. **StV0S**.

I am pushing it. She/he is pushing it.

 $G \sim A$  a-Vowel Stem Pattern

Gaditasga. S.IW od S. Aditasga. D.IW od S.

I am drinking. She is drinking.

 $G \sim G$  Vowel Stem Pattern\*

Goweli'a. AMPD. Gohweli'a. AMPD.

I am writing. He/She is writing. \*Context will often tell you if the verb refers to 'I' or to 'she/he/it'.

Examples:

Svgta inigi'a.

Do iyusdi detsigi'a?

You and I are eating apples.

What are you all eating?

The bears are pushing the car.

Otsisadosga hi'a kanesa.

Gigage aditasdi anaditasga dinadehyohvsgi.

Unvdi itsaditasga.

Sgwisdi anaditasga kemili.

You and I are eating apples.

What are you all eating?

The bears are pushing the car.

They and I are pushing this box.

The teachers are drinking wine.

You all are drinking milk.

The camels are drinking a lot.

Do iyusdi hohweli'a? What are you writing?

Gynahida digohweli otsohweli'a. They and I are writing a lengthy book.
