

Nouns in Cherokee Language
Draft Noun Dictionary

This is a draft dictionary and study of Cherokee language nouns in development by the Western Carolina University Cherokee Language Program.

Questions for study:

Should Cherokee Nouns be listed separately from Cherokee Verbs, Adjectives, and Particles?

How should Structural Features of Nouns be encoded in Dictionary Entries?

To what extent should the Source of each Noun be included?

How should the Spelling and Pronunciation be represented?

There are a number of different types of nouns in the Cherokee language. Different types of nouns behave in different ways in the language. Some nouns do not take plural markers. Nouns that do take plural markers can take different kinds of plural markers. Some nouns do not take person markers. Nouns that do take person markers can take either *agi-/agw-* set pronouns or *tsi-/g-* set pronouns. Some nouns must be owned or possessed. Some nouns indicate relationships between two sets of people and some nouns indicate reciprocal relationships.

1. Basic or Simple Nouns

Basic or Simple Nouns do not change no matter how they are used in sentences. These nouns do not take plural and they do not take person markers (unless there are exceptional circumstances in the way the speaker is using the noun). Simple Nouns can refer to entities that can be counted (Count Nouns) or they can refer to entities that cannot be counted (Mass Nouns). These nouns tend to refer to concrete objects of the natural world (animals, plants, etc.). Here are a few examples.

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4. Relationship Nouns

Relationship Nouns refer to relationships between two people or two sets of people. These relationships can be reciprocal or non-reciprocal. Sisters are in a reciprocal relationship; sisters are sisters to each other. Reciprocal Relationship Nouns are plural nouns marked with plural pronouns. Mother and child are in a non-reciprocal relationship; mother and child have different status in the relationship. Non-reciprocal relationships are marked with pronouns that indicate the relationship between the two people or groups of people.

Infinitive Instrument Nouns

Infinitive Instrument Nouns are formed on the Infinitive Stem. Infinitive Complements and Infinitive Obligations always show the *agi-/agw-* set pronouns. In contrast, Infinitive Instrument Nouns require *tsi-/g-* set pronouns. Infinitive Instrument Nouns refer to the instrument used to carry out the action of a verb.

Imperfective Agent Nouns are formed on the Imperfective Stem. These nouns reference people, for the most part, and so they show person marking. The activity is often pluralized with di- or d- before or combined with the person marker. For example, dihneshgesgi 'a carpenter', dinahneshgesgi 'carpenters', digahneshgesgi 'I am a carpenter', Dihahneshgesgi-tsu? 'Are you a carpenter?'
